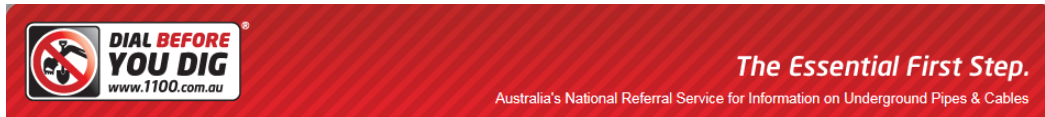


Trying to Locate Stormwater or Sewage Pipes



The City of Mitcham generally does not have plans showing the location of stormwater or sewage pipes on your property. Development Applications lodged after 2000 may show limited detail of the pipes, however an archive search will be required to retrieve any plans. There is no guarantee that plans will be found with the relevant information.

Council suggests that you try the following services *before* an archive search is requested:



Dial Before You Dig should be your first point of call for enquiries regarding residential drains/pipes.

Enquires can be made by calling 1100 or online at www.1100.com.au

The **Office of the Technical Regulator** can help with internal drainage plans if these were submitted by the plumber.

Note: Between 1977 and 1981 there was no requirement for sewer drain details to be submitted to SA Water.

Enquiries can be made by sending your request via email to otr.pid@sa.gov.au with the property address and contact details.

If **Dial Before You Dig** or the **Office of the Technical Regulator** cannot help with the location of your pipes, you may need to engage a plumber to assist you in locating the relevant pipes.

SA Water provides customers with information regarding water meters, government inspection points and details on mains connections.
